

ACHIEVEMENTS

- ❖ **One berth of 160 mtrs. length has been constructed and is ready for use by IOCL vessels.**
- ❖ **One berth of 108 mtrs. length has been constructed and is ready for use by Coast Guard Vessels in view of increased security measures taken up by the Coast Guard.**
- ❖ **A dry dock of dimension 75 mtrs length, 15 mtrs width and 11 mtrs depth has been constructed and commissioned on 12/01/09 to facilitate repair of all Port crafts and other vessels.**
- ❖ **Two 1350 BHP locomotives have been procured and commissioned on 16/07/08 & 23/07/08 respectively increasing the availability to 09 nos. to strengthen the working of Port Railway System.**
- ❖ **One Stacker-cum-Reclaimer of 3000 TPH capacity has been commissioned on 19/12/08 increasing the availability to 03 nos. to increase the output of Mechanized Iron Ore Handling Plant.**
- ❖ **Six internal roads of a total 18 Kms. have been concretized for smooth plying of intra-port transport.**
- ❖ **A Single Point Mooring in association with IOC was commissioned on 28th Dec., 2008 at Paradip for handling of their Very Large Crude Carriers [VLCCs] by Paradip Port. The crude oil is supplied to Haldia and Barunei Refineries through a pipeline.**
- ❖ **With a view to strengthen the Security System at the Port, Port has recently installed CCTV Security Surveillance System which functions round the clock as an enhanced security measures.**
- ❖ **With a view to simplify transactions between Port and Port users, Paradip Port introduced Electronic Data Interchange**

system. Web based messages are also being exchanged with users through the PCS central server.

- ❖ One 140 Ton capacity harbour Mobile crane has been commissioned for smooth and fast loading/unloading of cargoes from the vessels.
- ❖ Two 100 tons capacity harbour mobile cranes have been commissioned for smooth and fast loading/unloading of cargoes from the vessels.
- ❖ One RO-RO Jetty has been constructed and is ready for handling of project cargoes.
